



Getting the **Game Program File*** onto your Data Storage Device:

Ensure you already have an unzip program on your PC (*Windows XP should already have an Unzip Wizard operating*). If you do not, you can download the program for free from the same page you chose your code from (see the bottom of that page for the "Download WinZip" Hyperlink).

- Once you choose which file you want, click the 'download' hyperlink! A *Summary Text Box*, with information about the code update will appear. Another window asking you **what you would like to do** will appear:
 >> **OPEN** or **SAVE** <<.

Note, if no window appeared, your settings are set to **BLOCK POP-UPS. Click Tools, Pop-Up Blocker and **Always Allow Pop-Ups from this site ...** (the downloads you choose are the only pop-ups from the Stern Pinball site). If you click to allow pop-ups, >>>> **reclick** <<<< the 'download' hyperlink.*

- Always choose "**SAVE**". Select a destination for your file to be saved on your PC. For explanation purposes, we're going to use "Desktop" as the location (*or destination*).
- Find the **zip file** you just downloaded on your Desktop and double-click it to activate the UNZIP program or UNZIP Wizard. Highlight (SELECT) the file which has the extension **BIN** not TXT.

THIS IS THE GAME PROGRAM FILE TO BE LOADED ONTO YOUR CPU BOARD!

>>>> Extract this file which has the BIN extension and save to your desktop (*or folder of your choice*). <<<<

- *Insert your Data Storage Device into your USB Port. Allow the computer to recognize it (if it does not recognize the Data Storage Device consult the manual or manufacturer of your PC).*
- *Open your My Computer window. Depending on what DRIVE LETTER your computer assigned to your stick, double click it. Go to your desktop, "**click, drag and drop**" the file ending with **BIN** to the window (Folder of your Data Storage Device you just opened).*

Properly stop the USB Device (consult the manual or manufacturer of your PC).

DO NOT JUST PULL OUT THE Data Storage Device, this can corrupt the file!!

Find the small 'program running' icon which you can right click on to 'stop' the device so you can safely remove the device.
